Domaine de l'Amauve 2018 Laurances Red (Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret)

In this wine, hints of brandy and raspberry coulis are sharpened by anise and bramble tones. A ripe, voluminous blend of Grenache and Syrah, it's framed by ripe, dusty tannins and a lingering licorice kiss. It's ready to drink now but should reward well through 2025.

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Domaine de l'Amauve 2017 Réserve Red (Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret)

This concentrated blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah floods the palate with flavors of muddled black plums and brandy-soaked cherries. Velveteen and weighty, it's a full-bodied red softened by fine, furry tannins and a lift of crushed stone and salt. It's drinking quite well now but should hold through 2025.
