Fermented in tanks and barriques, matured on the less for six to seven months.

Soft, yielding, easy going and juicy. The alcohol is high, but this has juicy, succulent plum and blackberry fruit. The oak lends a welcome, seductive sheen to the ripe fruit, and the overall effect is highly delicious, concentrated and impressive. A glass would be enough however, as this is highly potent! Grown on La Plaine and La Première Terrasse areas. Partly matured in oak barrels, from new to third use.
